Request for Proposals: Identify natural resource conservation issues for regional ocean planning in New England

Questions (and responses) received by August 14, 2012 deadline.

1. *What is the status of NROC recruiting and enlisting the working group referenced on page 4 of the RFP?*

The group is not formed yet. NROC expects that the working group will convene for the first time in September.

2. *Is it safe to assume the working group will work gratis – i.e. as advisors and not contractors?*

3. *Is the working group going to be assembled once the contract is awarded?*

4. *How heavily will working group feedback be incorporated into direction and decisions for the contractor?*
