### CRG Living Shorelines: Update

- Living shorelines project has been the main focus of CHR Committee over the last few years
- The project is winding down over the next year (end date of 3/31/22)
- Finalized versions of the literature review and the monitoring metrics and protocols guide.



### CRG Living Shorelines: Remaining Deliverable

- Develop a storymap to showcase case studies for ME Maquoit, NH Wagon Hill, MA Collins Cove, RI Rose Larissa Park, CT Stratford Point
- Develop regulatory guidance. Proposed next steps include:
  - First, compile and document the permitting pathways for living shorelines in each state.
  - Second, document the real or perceived need to make recommended changes to those permitting pathways. This can be accomplished via desktop work from the project team as well as perhaps folding in discussion/workshop into a future NROC meeting.
