NROC Ocean Planning Committee (OPC) Background

- Began sharing information and coordinating on ocean planning in mid-2000s
- Established the Northeast Ocean Data Portal with regional partners in 2009
- Supported the development of the 2016 Northeast Ocean Plan
- Reestablished in 2018 to include the tribes, NEFMC, states, and federal agencies
- In 2021, in partnership with MARCO, selected to host the Regional Wildlife Science Entity





1.1 Host OPC Meetings


1.2 Establish work groups or subcommittees to support regional ocean management and planning priorities

- 3.3 Coordinate data work groups and data development with related NROC and partner activities






Strategy OPC-4: Host and foster the Regional Wildlife Science Entity (RWSE)
